Today in the Gospel of the Fifth Sunday of Easter Jesus speaks of the necessity of loving as He loves. This seems impossible. Jesus gave His life for you. Can you give of yourself as He did? The truthful answer is "I cannot." Then, what is there to be done? Spiritual suicide? Or just to give up and think this is impossible but just to keep your head up, or down, and go on, hoping for the best. Jesus knows that on your own strength this is not possible, but then you may ask, "What can I do?" The Lord wants you to recognize that, first of all you cannot love anybody. Well, that sounds absurd. "I love my children." Yes, we can love others up to a point and that is when they love us in return, but what if they don't return your love? You hit a barrier and this is good to recognize, that really you, of yourself cannot love as Jesus has loved you. He gave his life for you when you were a sinner. He gave His life for me when I was hating my parents and my brother. I could not love them. So, the first step is to recognize your complete inadequacy in loving other people and then, you can beg the Lord the grace to be able to love and to love just as He loved you. It can only be a grace of God. That is why the Lord allows you to see that, no matter how hard you try to love the other person there is always something that stops you from completely giving yourself to them in sacrifice.

Let us then ask the Lord, in fervent prayer, the gift of being able to love those around us, and those also who may be far away, as well. The Lord is kind and merciful but demanding at the same time, but because loving the others is the only way to happiness.

May the Lord grant us the grace to see our inability to love but also to wait with hope this tremendous gift to be able to love as He has loved us.
