Today we celebrate the feast of the Ascension of the Lord. This is a greatly underestimated feast and also not well understood. Without the ascension there can be no Holy Spirit sent to us. It is from His place in Heaven that the Lord sends us His Spirit which is essential for us to get into eternal life which we can experience even now in this life. I hope that all may have this week the sense of His absence in our lives so that we can long for His coming next weekend at Pentecost and so more deeply receive this Spirit.
