Today is the feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ given to us in the Eucharist. It is a great mystery and yet one that assures us of the closeness of the Lord. After Jesus ascended into heaven he remains with us in spirit but also through His real presence in the Eucharistic species. The Lord did not want to leave us alone and that is why He gave us the Eucharist. Of course, the eucharist is real food and drink. It is life-giving nourishment for the soul. Ultimately, it gives those who receive it worthily and with dignity, eternal life, even in this present age. What a wonderful gift and an enormous one at that. Yet so often you can take it for granted and miss out on the graces that come with the sacrament. What can be done to remedy this ailment in us?

One thing that can help is to come to the mass sometime before it starts. My father always insisted on leaving 30 minutes before the mass was due to start so that we could have 15 minutes in the church to pray. This did help to enter into the celebration. When St. John Vianney saw a man every day in the Church before mass just staring at the tabernacle he asked him what he was doing. The man answered, "I'm looking at Him and He's looking at me!" Have you ever just wasted time with Jesus or just spent time with Him? I believe many people are afraid of facing the Lord in His Eucharistic presence yet He is gladdened when we spend time with Him and it can settle you down to approach the sacrament in a more open way

May the Lord grant us His grace to deepen our appreciation of His gift. to us in the Eucharist
