Looking ahead.....

How to understand this great mystery of the Holy Trinity? The one I find most helpful is this: The Father, in all eternity, wanted to share His Godhead with someone and 'generated' the Son. The Son is so grateful that He has the same power and omnipotence as the Father that he gives himself totally back to the Father in complete love.

This mutual love between the two persons is the Holy Spirit, also a person and also God. So the Trinity is in a continual movement of love, back and forth among the three persons. Yes, that's nice and good, but what's it got to do with my life? Well, since the Son has become one of us. He is a fully human being, and so a man is now part of the Trinity and by extension, so are we given this hope that we can join Him one day. In his first epistle, St. John says, "When He appears we shall be like Him, because we shall see Him as He really is." (1John 3:2). In other words we shall be like God and come to share in His Godhead.

This is a tremendous promise for all of us, given that we are all sinners! One day we will be like God! What a promise for a poor weak person like me that I will have a share in this continual passing back and forwards of the love of the Trinity.

Secondly, in the Gospel of today it can be seen the humility of God. Each of the persons of the Trinity gives the glory or praise to the other.

Let us pray that we can have this true humility, which means to just see the truth, and that is that we are completely unworthy of such a great promise and yet it is on offer for us for free! May the Lord grant us His Spirit to accept this enormous love of God for us in spite of our smallness and unworthiness.
