Today is the feast of Saints Peter and Paul. Why combine them? There is a reason and that is the Church needs both of them. Whilst it's true that the Church was founded by Jesus on the rock of St. Peter, it needs the balancing of St. Paul. Peter represents the more institutional aspect of the Church and Paul the more Charismatic. Both are essential. There have been moments when the Church was too institutional and moments when it was not. For example, in a family the Father has the role of being the authority and the mother the Heart.

Every person needs to have an experience of both aspects. You need discipline but you also need in the family a place for the heart to rule at times, as often God speaks in a deeper and more mysterious way through the mother and often more rightly.

So in the same way, in the Church there is the need of discipline to produce good order but also the more free charismatic element which is more open to the Holy Spirit. This is because the danger is to be too legalistic, on the one hand or to be so 'free' and open to the Spirit that disorder can enter. Basically we need both.

There is a passage in St. Paul's letter to the Galatians in which He corrects St. Peter, who was siding with the Jewish Christians who wanted the Pagans who had become Christians to adopt the Jewish practices. Paul insisted rightly that Jesus came to bring something new and to abolish the old Law with it's precepts and replace it with the new law of Love. St. Peter sees his mistake and thanks St. Paul, eventually. In the end we need each other to correct each other as we can be blind to our own faults and sins and not realize the damage we are doing or can do.

Let us pray to these saints to protect the Church and to guide it and also that we can all be evangelizers like them and bring the 'Good News' to all those around us. Fr. Paul
