Today's Gospel is all about the mission. Seeing the misery of the people Jesus gathers twelve men and gives the task of going out to preach the Good News. And what just is that? It is first of all to recognize your state of sinfulness. This is the first action of the Holy Spirit, which is to be convicted of your sins. Then, in this state of sorrow for your sins you become open to believing in the Love of the Lord for you. That Jesus Christ came just for sinners. That He loves you in the midst of your sins and will never stop loving you. This is the ancient "Kerygma" of the early church, which means the proclamation of the Good News. This is what Jesus sends the Apostles to do, so that hearing this message people's lives begin to change. Hope is restored and reconciliation with enemies can take place. The darkness that enshrouds many people is dispelled and all this through words. It is possible that you may dismiss this as you have heard too many words and doubt the effect that they can have on people's lives. But I would like you to recall the times when you either received a word from someone that changed your thinking Or you had the grace to give a word that stopped someone doing something they would regret for the rest of their lives. Do not devalue the power of your words to help change another person's heart especially with the grace of the Lord to help you.

Secondly, please note that all the twelve Apostles have names and are real people with real personalities. They are not far from us, really. Let us pray that like them we can have the grace to give the Good News to those around us, especially those suffering or doubting the love of the Lord for them.

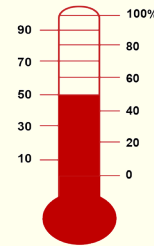
