As we continue going through Chapter 6 of John's gospel we hear today how the people could not understand what Jesus was talking about when He said He was 'the bread of life come down from Heaven.' These people knew Him; had seen Him grow up. How could He now say He came down from Heaven? A similar difficulty can be with you. You get accustomed to the bread of the Eucharist and it seems just like nothing special. Perhaps you do not feel anything or have any reverential sense and it's difficult to believe that this is really the Body of Christ, a man who died 2000 years ago. Faith, however is not based on feelings, as, certainly, love is not based on feelings, but is "proved" when all feeling has disappeared and people stay together. Whether you feel anything or not, the Eucharist gives eternal life to those who believe. There is are many graces available for us in each mass where the body and blood of the Lord become present and most important is that it makes present Jesus' 'Passover' from death to life. He gives Himself so that you and I may have life eternally. So this means that His resurrection is also celebrated in every Eucharist and that no matter how hopeless the situation we can all say, as we do at Easter, 'Christ is Risen', 'He is truly Risen.' May we all experience this resurrection.

JUBILEE OF THE CATHOLIC MISSION IN THE TURKS & CAICOS ISLANDS

In order to get a **Plenary Indulgence**, which is a full remission of Purgatory, for either yourself or for the soul of someone who has died, the following conditions are needed. sacramental confession within a few days before or after.

1. Passing through the Holy Door
2. Praying the creed, the Our Father, a Hail Mary for Pope Francis' intentions.
3. Attending Mass in this Church and receiving Holy Communion.

It is also possible to get a partial indulgence if one or other of the above conditions are not met.
