## HOLY DOOR

### JUBILEE OF THE CATHOLIC MISSION IN THE TURKS & CAICOS ISLANDS

In order to get a **Plenary Indulgence**, which is a full remission of Purgatory, for either yourself or for the soul of someone who has died, the following conditions are needed. sacramental confession within a few days before or after.

1. Passing through the Holy Door
2. Praying the creed, the Our Father, a Hail Mary for Pope Francis' intentions.
3. Attending Mass in this Church and receiving Holy Communion.

It is also possible to get a partial indulgence if one or other of the above conditions are not met.

## DAILY MASS

Daily Mass in the summer (July-August) will be in **St. Joseph's Room**, known also as the **Red Room**, next to the parish office.

In Today's Gospel Jesus emphasizes His 'Physicality'. He, God, really took on our flesh and His flesh gives us life. But what does this mean for you today? In a strange and almost contradictory way, it means to be filled with the Spirit. To have life means to be joyful, to enter fully into the life that the Lord wants for you but how often you make it smaller and easier to handle. "Let me alone so I can rest." Rest is what you want or relaxation and yet it never satisfies you. It can leave you empty. The Eucharist is Jesus' gift to you so that you can open your heart to being able to do His will. That is where you will find life and have it abundantly. It also does not mean you will not suffer but even the difficulties will be turned to the good and help you lead a rewarding life.

A second point is when Jesus says 'Live in Me..' what does this mean.? To me it means that the life that Jesus lived must be played out in our own lives. Ultimately, there must be dying to yourself and experiencing through this the resurrection.

Finally, why does Jesus become so close to our earthly life? It can only be that He loves you and me so much that He wants to be one with us , not only in the Spirit but even in our small little fleshly lives that we live. May the Lord grant us life through His body and blood.
