I invite you to think about what makes you suffer and to ask the Lord to be enlightened about the good that comes from it. If you stay in the situation of complaining and grumbling about your suffering , instead of embracing it as a necessary part of life then you waste a wonderful opportunity to grow spiritually and in intimacy with the Lord.

May the Lord grant us all the grace to embrace our cross and to see the meaning of it for our lives.
