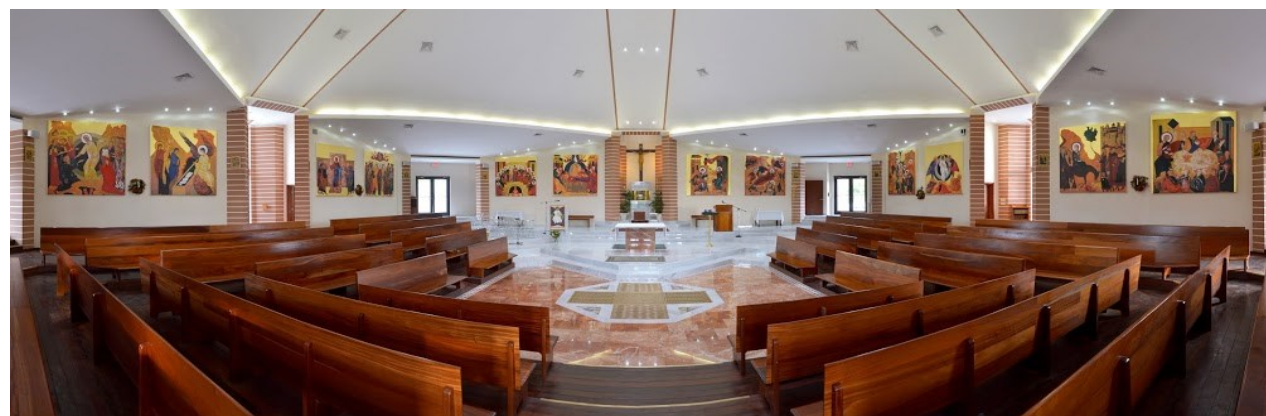

Many times we see people who do not act according to the law or the rules and are tempted to judge them, or we do actually, judge them! Yet, the saints were often great sinners whose lives were changed after meeting Jesus Christ. For example, St. Peter, St. Paul and St. Matthew. St. Matthew, whose feast day was earlier this week, 21 September, was a tax collector who became one of the twelve Apostles and author of one of the Gospels. Because he was a Jew and was collecting taxes for the Romans empire, he was “ex-communicated “ by his own people. No self respecting Jewish person would have anything to do with him. Yet he converts at the drop of a hat! He leaves all his wealth and followed Jesus. Just seeing and hearing the words of Jesus touched him deeply converted him. He saw in Jesus the love of God for him. As with St. Matthew we too can always have the chance to repent and change our lives, while we are still alive. So those sinners that we judge also have the chance for repentance until the last moment of their lives and many do repent. In my own family I have seen such conversions.

Let us not be like the Pharisees in today’s Gospel who failed to recognize the way of righteousness proclaimed by John the Baptist, and so failed to repent.

Let us pray that we may repent of our Judgemental character by seeing our own “Phariseism” and our own sins, and so be brought to true conversion, by the grace and mercy of Jesus Christ. We, too, are sinners in need of conversion and therefore we can all rejoice in this fact, that Jesus came to call the sick and not the healthy.
