Given today's Gospel it seems as if It's better not to get married! Marriage is for life. When Jesus Christ gave this teaching everyone was surprised. It is very difficult to stay with the same person for the rest of your life. There are obviously cases where there was not a real marriage agreement on behalf of both of the partners and so it is not a marriage and can be annulled. Apart from these, which are the exception and not the rule, Marriage is for life, for better or worse, for richer or poorer etc. That is because it is a sacrament and the only sacrament that is made by the people themselves. The Priest is merely a witness that they have publicly made their vows.

The question then arises how to put up and accept the other person with all their faults and sins? There is only one answer to that and that is, "you need the grace of God." It's the only way to stay married.

Why this "exclusivity" of only one other person for the rest of my life? Because of the need to have a stable place or situation where children can have a security and stability. This is because every person needs stability and security, particularly when growing up. The Lord has designed us this way.

Finally, Marriage is a sign that God can never abandon us, His Church which is His Bride. Let us ask the Lord for this assurance of His never-ending love.
